David Stine designs and crafts furniture, working only with wood that he has harvested and sawn himself, including black cherry, white oak, black walnut, tulip poplar and other local species. He culls dead and dying trees from family lands and works with local arborists. He takes stewardship of the land seriously in order to ensure responsible sustainability of this natural resource.

Every piece is hand crafted and hand finished using traditional methods of joinery and construction. He uses only natural and environmentally-friendly finishes, like linseed oil, or finishes of his own creation, like black walnut hulls soaked in vinegar.

The design of each piece is driven entirely by the inner beauty of the boards; as he saws each log, he sees what he will build. Every piece he creates is done with an eye toward maximizing the raw, natural beauty of the wood. Each piece is a testament to the grace and majesty of the tree, which lives on in a beautiful, functional way.
