He is the fourth generation to steward his family's land in rural Illinois, where he sustainably harvests his own lumber, mills his own boards, and crafts every piece of furniture by hand.

Design inspiration comes from the forest itself, by how and where the trees grew. As David mills the boards and the inner beauty of the wood is revealed, he often sees what he will build.

Each piece is a testament to the beauty and majesty of the tree from which it came. David's designs let the wood speak for itself.

ABOUT

David Stine was raised on a dairy farm in Dow, Illinois, where he learned the art of woodworking from his grandfather and father. He is a graduate of Penn State University and holds a law degree from George Washington University.

He founded David Stine Furniture in 1997 while in law school. He practiced law for one year before devoting himself full time to woodworking. In 2002, he moved back to Dow, 35 miles north of St. Louis, where he renovated an 1871 farmhouse and built a showroom, woodshop, kiln, sawmill, and drying sheds for his work.

Clients are seen by appointment only. They travel to Dow to consult personally with David, tour the shop and showroom, choose their boards, and enjoy a day at the farm.

THE PROCESS

Every piece of furniture David Stine creates is handcrafted from American hardwoods sustainably harvested from his family's forests. The design of each piece is informed by the tree itself—the wood in its most natural form is the first inspiration.



It starts in the forest, where the wood is sustainably harvested.



The logs are brought to the farm, where they are milled by hand.



The wood slabs are sorted, stacked, and kiln- and air-dried for up to three years.



When an order is placed, Dave Stine works directly with each client to choose the right slab and the right design for their project. Every piece is handcrafted using traditional methods of joinery and construction.



Only environmentally safe, non-toxic finishes are used, including Dave Stine's proprietary hand-rubbed oil finish.



Each piece is hand finished and delivered to its new home.
