Our signature work, featuring solid slabs of sustainably harvested American hardwoods with dramatic, natural edges that are silky smooth to the touch. Each piece is one-of-a-kind.

Solid, natural multi-board wood with conventional edges, at a competitive price point. We work only with solid, natural, sustainably harvested American hardwoods. No veneers, imports, engineered, or treated materials.

OUR FINISHES

We offer two standard finish options:

OUR PROPRIETARY HAND-RUBBED OIL FINISH

- A beautiful silky-smooth finish which seals the wood and prevents rings and stains. This is the finish we've developed over 25 years, and it is the gold standard in the industry. It involves a two-step proprietary process: the wood is sealed and then a hand-rubbed oil is applied for the final step. This is the finish we recommend.
- Advantages: extremely matte but not dull. The wood is protected, the natural wood shows through, it looks and feel silky smooth, and it wears beautifully over time. If you scratch the surface, it can be spot treated rather than having to re-finish the entire piece.
- Disadvantages: None.

SATIN LACQUER


- A film-based finish applied directly on top of the wood. Though it is satin, it has a slight sheen to it. It is shinier than our oil finish.
- Advantages: Slick(er) top
- Disadvantages: Cannot be spot treated; if scratched the entire top will need to be refinished.

BLACKENED + DARKENED

• Any of our woods can be blackened or darkened, then finished with either of the above finishes. A \$150-\$500 upcharge applies.

SPECIALTY

• We generally do not offer specialty finishes, but inquiries are welcome.



Our bases are custom-made for every item. Standard styles include legs, pedestals, slabs, and trestles in wood or steel. Custom designs, materials, and powder coating available.




